PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

She started her professional career in 1988 at the European Space Agency, ESA, Noordwijk (the Netherlands), where she was responsible for the technical management of various contracts with the European aerospace industry in the fields of communication and satellite navigation (GNSS). In 1995, she was appointed responsible for the technical management of the European EGNOS navigation satellite system.

She joined Aena in 1996, where she held different positions. In 1996, she was appointed Head of the EGNOS programme Office. In 2005, she was appointed Head of the GNSS Development Division, within the Aena's Directorate of Engineering and Technical Exploitation.

In July 2008, she was appointed Head of Strategy and Planning of the Directorate of Air Navigation of Aena and in March 2012, Head of International Development and Convergence, a position she holds today. She is responsible for managing all the international relationships, policies, business development activities and international programs of the Air Navigation Directorate. In particular, since 2008, she has been responsible for negotiating, directing and coordinating the participation of Aena in the SJJ (SESAR Joint Undertaking) programme, focused on modernising the European air traffic management system. She is the representative of ENAIRE (formerly Aena) at the SJU PC (Programme Committee) and the alternate representative of ENAIRE (formerly Aena) at the SJU AdB (Administrative Board).
